INSTRUCTIONS

STANDING HORSE FIGURINE

MATERIALS

• Bisque: DB22685

Sponge

• Small Round Brush

• Detail Brush

• Medium Flat Brush

• Paints: 13, 25, 88, 61, 15, 31, 29



- 1. Wipe the bisque down with a damp sponge to remove ceramic dust.
- 2. Mix the light brown color on a paint palette by combining # 13 and # 25 half and half.
- 3. Paint the body of the horse with this color using a small round brush and a medium flat brush. Skip the eyes and the stripe on the front of the face.
- 4. Paint the light stripe with #88.
- 5. Use a detail brush and Chocolate Brown # 61 to paint the eyes and fine lines around the eyes. Use the same color to blend in the eyebrows.
- 6. Use a small round brush to paint the snout with #61.
- 7. Use a detail brush to carefully outline the edges of the hair with dark Brown # 15. Then use a larger brush to fill in the rest of the mane with # 15.
- 8. Paint the legs from knees down with #15.
- 9. Paint the hooves with Black # 31. Also make a small black dot in the center of each eye.
- 10. Paint the base of the figurine with Green # 29.

INSTRUCTIONS

COWBOY BOOT

MATERIALS

• Bisque: G7441 or C40310

• Sponge • Pen

• Small Round Brush

• Detail Brush

• Medium Flat Brush

• Paints: 69, 98, 15, 19



1. Wipe the bisque down with a damp sponge to remove ceramic dust.

2. Draw the flame outlines on the front and back of the boot as shown in the sample image.

3. Use a small round brush and Orange # 69 to paint the tips of the flames. Continue this color to the middle of the overall flame shapes, front and back of the boot.

4. Use the same brush to blend Red # 98 from the tip of the boot to the middle of the flame, and from the heel to the middle of the flame on the back of the boot.

5. Use a medium flat brush to paint inside of the boot solid Red.

6. Apply 3 coats of Red # 98 along the top edges of the boot.

7. Use a detail brush to carefully outline the flames with dark Brown #15.

8. Fill the remaining areas of the boot with dark brown using a small round brush and medium flat brush as needed.

9. Use a sponge to blend brown and red on the tip of the boot.

10. Add some decorative yellow dots with # 19. Make these dots with the back of a small roundbrush dipped in Yellow.
