MATERIALS

CCX3179 Snowy the Snowman Medium Brush Liner Brush Sponge

COLORS

CMM 90 - Red Hot CMM 55 - Sea Mist CMM 47 - Deep Sea CMM 19 - Banana Boat CMM 31 - Licorice CMM 67 - Snowflake CMM 69 - Orange Juice CMM 64 - Blue Ice

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Start out by painting the snowman's head and body with 3 coats of Blue Ice.
- 2. After the blue has dried up a little, we are going to sponge on 2 coats of Snowflake. Start by dipping your sponge into the Snowflake paint and then tap off some of the excess on a paper towel. Then you'll sponge the Snowflake paint all over the face and body, two layers.
- 3. Next, paint the mittens and a couple of tassels on the scarf with 3 coats of Sea Foam.
- 4. Paint the band on the hat and some of the tassels on the scarf with 3 coats of Banana Boat.
- 5. For the scarf body and the trim on the mittens, apply 3 coats of Red Hot.
- 6. Use a detail brush to apply 3 coats of Orange Juice to the nose of the snowman.
- 7. Next, we are going to paint the hat and remaining tassels on the scarf with 3 coats of Deep Sea.
- 8. Finally we are going to paint on 2-3 coats of Licorice to the buttons and eyes, then put a dot of Snowflake on the eyes for a sparkle.

TIPS

- 3 coats of paint will give you nice solid colors.
- The harder your press on your brush, the heavier the lines will be. So when you're filling in small spaces, use very light pressure.
- Make sure to unload the excess paint from the sponge before applying it to the body in order to get a more even application
